



## How to Prepare Recyclables

<p><b>GLASS:</b> Jars and bottles only!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>NO</b> light bulbs, dishes, glassware, window glass, mirrors, or ceramics</li> <li>• Remove lids and metal rings, empty and rinse clean.</li> </ul> 	<p><b>TIN CANS:</b> Empty food, paint, aerosol cans only!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>NO</b> chemicals, scrap metal, or vehicle parts.</li> <li>• Empty, rinse clean, and remove labels. Ends of cans can stay attached. Flattening of food cans is appreciated.</li> </ul> 	<p><b>ALUMINUM:</b> Cans only!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Drain liquid and rinse cans clean. Flattening is appreciated.</li> </ul> 	<p><b>PLASTIC:</b> Bottles only!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>NO</b> plastic packaging, plastic bags or Styrofoam.</li> <li>• Look for #1, #2, #5 mark (milk jugs, soda, and water bottles).</li> <li>• Rinse clean; discard cap.</li> </ul>  	<p><b>CARDBOARD/PAPER/CARTONS:</b> Milk, juice, broth, soup, and other food &amp; beverage cartons</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>What is a carton?</b>It’s a type of food and beverage packaging. There are two types: <b>shelf-stable</b> (broth, soup, soy milk, juice, milk, cereal, soda, wine) and <b>refrigerated</b> (milk, juice, cream, egg substitutes).</li> <li>• Drain liquid.</li> </ul>

Place glass, cardboard, paper, tin cans, aluminum cans, plastic, and cartons together **LOOSELY** in recycling bin.

### NEWSPAPERS/MAGAZINES

- **JUNK MAIL** is acceptable
- Newspapers (including shiny inserts), magazines, and telephone books are acceptable.
- Keep papers as dry as possible! If rain/snow is predicted, please wait until your next recycling week to set out.

**Please Note:**The Village recycles **ONLY** the items listed in this brochure. Items such as, plastic packaging, and non-recyclable containers should be placed in your regular trash.
